COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is designed for advanced art students that have successfully completed Art 1-3. Students will work on a continued development of skills and creativity by using different mediums and techniques. By the end of this course, students should have several pieces of distinguished artwork and a completed portfolio.

EXPECTATIONS:

Maintaining a Sketchbook: This includes observational studies, drawings, research, class notes, pre-planning, and critiques. There will be a sketchbook assignment each week.

Class Participation: Students will be responsible for managing time to complete projects when they are due. There will be a lot of independence in this course, so self-motivation is crucial for success. Students are also responsible for participating in class critiques; offering and receiving constructive feedback for works of art from peers.

GRADING:

1. Projects: 50%:

Our goal is to produce a finished project every week. Each project will be worth 100 points. In addition to turning in the project, a Sketchbook pre-plan and a Rubric must be completed.

2. Participation: 25%

Students receive a weekly participation grade. This includes classroom behavior, respect, using materials responsibly, and clean-up.

3. In-Class Work: 25%

Students will receive ongoing sketchbook grades. This also consists of self motivated participation, in-class drawings, project preparation, research, etc.

MATERIALS: Each student will have their own bin in the classroom to keep their materials in. Students will have access to all materials in the art room, but are welcome (and encouraged) to bring in materials from home.

- Pencil
- Hand held Eraser
- Clorox Wipes (Bleach Free due to Student Allergies)

- Portfolio (Large Folder for Artwork)
