COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course provides opportunities for self-motivated students who have successfully completed advanced level courses. Students will work on a continued development of skills and creativity by guided independent art. By the end of this course, students should have a variety of finished, highly developed portfolio pieces of artwork.

GRADING:

1. Projects: 50%:

1 Project will be due every 3 weeks. Each project turned in will be graded with an Independent Study Rubric for 100 points. In addition to turning in the project, a Sketchbook pre-plan must be included.

2. Participation: 25%

Students receive 10 points a day (= 50 points per week) for their participation. This includes classroom behavior, respect, using materials responsibly, and clean-up.

3. In-Class Work: 25%

Students will receive ongoing sketchbook grades. This consists of self motivated participation, in-class drawings, project preparation, research, etc.
